


A message from Catherine & Annie Welcome to the latest issue of the 'Cantata Newsletter'

Well, what an eventful few months we've had! Cantata Choirs have been broadcast across the world, we've made our first CD and performed in the cultural Olympiad in Chester; as well as ongoing preparations for the big Jubilee Weekend...

On Tuesday 20th March, the combined Cantata Daytime Choirs came together and recorded their first CD at St Martin's Church, Higher Poynton. It was an exciting morning—beginning for Annie & Catherine at 7.30am when we arrived to get everything set up with Steven, our lovely sound recordist. Singers began arriving just after 8.30 and by 9.30am we were ready to roll.

Such was the outstanding discipline of the singers that we didn't have to do several takes of each track as predicted.

Quite the opposite in fact—Steven

was very pleased with the quality of the individual songs and consequently we rattled through the recording at a great pace and the choir had finished by lunchtime! However, Monica still had to record her readings and by the time we'd completed the full recording, it was closer to 2pm.



We were then thrown into a bit of a panic the following week when the promised CD for Two Lochs Radio TWO LOCHS RADIO failed to arrive... and was then discovered two days later at

a different address! Good thing its destination was a very small community.

It was good to hear the choir singing their hearts out during the Holy Week broadcasts and again in the 'omnibus' on Easter Sunday. Well done to everyone who took part. Two Lochs had to adapt our recording to fit with their chosen readings for the week, but all in all it worked well and the radio station has had a lot of positive feedback regarding our performance.

At the time of writing, we're 'almost there' with getting the CD production line in place. It's a complicated business when you're new to it! With a bit of luck we should have 200 copies rolling off the production line in the near future and then we can all say we're 'recorded artists'.
